Out-of-office responsibilities will include assisting with the stations' marketing efforts and events, promoting at events (sports games, local bars and restaurants, clubs, and retail locations), and assisting with the set-up and execution of live broadcasts at various locations.

**The internship is a non-paid internship** and the length depends on the school's requirements.
